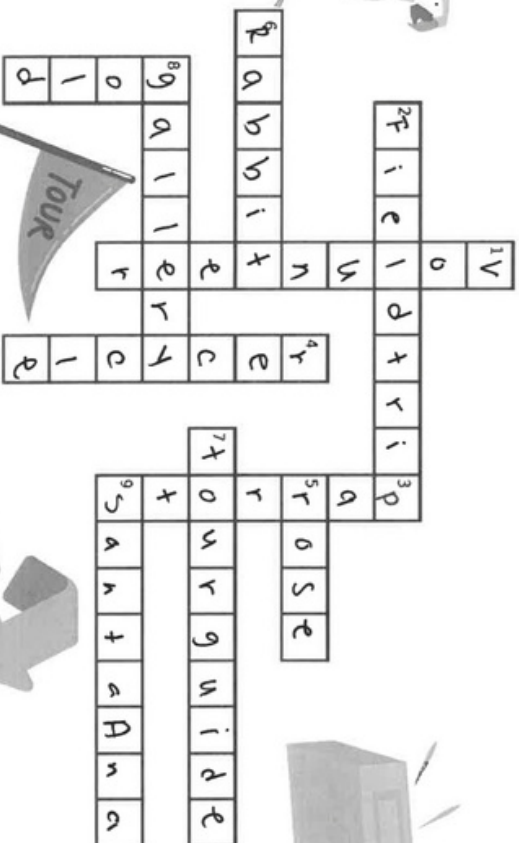

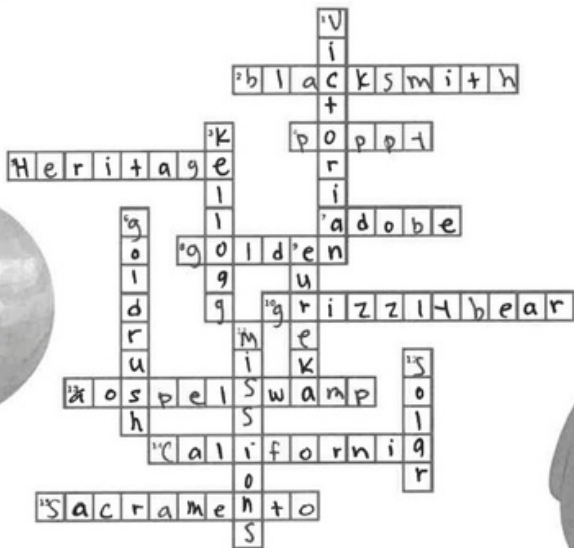


Across:

12. Using the sun as energy

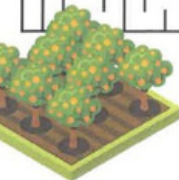
